

New Hartford Sr. High School College Bridging Application

When looking at courses to take on a college campus, please keep the following College Bridging Guidelines in mind:

- Students are responsible for transportation to the college campus.
- Students are expected to comply with any rules the college may have regarding high school students enrolling in their courses.
- Students may participate in bridging opportunities during the **school day** during their **Senior Year**.
- **Students may only enroll in a college course through one of our bridging programs if New Hartford High School does not have a comparable course available.**
- **Seniors** who take a college course during the school day can include the course as part of the minimum schedule requirement for the year. A college course generally counts as one-half credit toward the required 5.5-credit minimum (including Phys. Ed.). The blended schedule must be developed to insure that students are not late for the start of a class at New Hartford High School (the only exception to this is a lab component that meets at a different time from the class). **Seniors** may leave a class at NHHS twenty minutes early, if necessary, to get to the college class on time.
- **Sophomores and juniors** may bridge outside the school day. Should there be an instance where a sophomore or junior is eligible to take a college course during the school day, the student must take the full schedule requirement at New Hartford High School. The blended schedule must be developed to insure that sophomores and juniors do not miss any instructional time at New Hartford High School.
- College courses taken during the school day will be shown on the student's schedule. Grades will be recorded on the student's report card and transcript.
- College courses taken outside the school day are not considered part of the student's program of study at NHHS and therefore will not show on the schedule or report card/transcript.
- College grades will not be included in the marking period or cumulative GPA.
- **College courses do not fulfill graduation requirements** and credit will NOT be awarded for college courses.
